

### **GOOD MORNING/INVOCATION – Bobby Schuller**

BS: This is the day the Lord has made. We will rejoice and be glad in it. Hello. (AUDIENCE - good morning) The Holy Spirit is here, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is (AUDIENCE – freedom) freedom. Isn't that good news? There's freedom literally right here in the house. I think there's something about our worship that draws the Spirit into the building, and a lot of that's a mystery. Right? We have to hold some of that loosely. We don't always know what that means and how that practically works out, but what we can know is where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. I wanted to read you a Bible verse that has been on my heart a lot. Psalm 8 chapter 2, "Through the praise," someone say praise (AUDIENCE – praise) "through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against your enemies to silence the foe and the avenger." Notice that praise creates a stronghold for us and it silences the enemy. Right? So the enemy says your life is over. The enemy says everything's going bad. Enemy says, you're going to lose. The enemy says you're not saved. The enemy says all these things? We say thank you, Lord. We say hallelujah. We say, that's all a lie and the enemy gets silenced. Amen? Lift your hands with me. Father, we come boldly before your throne. You are the chain-breaking, life-giving, world transforming Son of God, and we come here to worship you, Jesus, to lift up your name. You can heal, you can save, you can deliver, you can rescue and you will. We say it and declare it by faith, and we thank you and it's in Jesus name we pray, all God's people said, (AUDIENCE – amen) amen. Turn around and say hello to someone. Greet them in the name of the Lord.

### **SCRIPTURE – Acts 10:44-48, 11:15-18 – Tim McCalmont**

We find ourselves today in the 10th and 11th chapter of the book of Acts. J.B. Phillips, the great biblical scholar and translator, once said as he was translating the Book of Acts, he felt like he was rewiring an old house with the power turned on. And that's really what it's like when we come out of the Word of God, we have that sense of electrification, as we read. In Acts chapter 10, Peter has come to Caesarea in the house of Cornelius, a Gentile, a Roman centurion, an officer over many. And he comes and he shares the Gospel there with his community of Gentile believers. And he shares the good news that God was for all people, as the Spirit had led him to preach. Verse 44. "While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message. The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on Gentiles, for they heard them speaking in tongues and praising God. Then Peter said, surely no one can stand in the way of their being baptized with water. They have received the Holy Spirit just as we have. So he ordered that they be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked Peter to stay with them for a few days." After that time, Peter traveled back to Jerusalem to tell the Christian leaders in Jerusalem what had happened. And in verse 15 of chapter 11, it says, "As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit came on them as he had on us at the beginning. Then I remembered what the Lord had said. John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit. So if God gave them the same gift that he gave us who believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I to think that I could stand in God's way? When they heard this, they had no further objections and praised God, saying so then even to Gentiles, God has granted repentance that leads to life." This is the word of the Lord. Amen.

### **MESSAGE/PRAYER – Bobby Schuller "The Spirit of Life"**

It's interesting what Tim said when he read the scripture, that when a particular theologian had translated the Book of Acts from Greek into English, it was like he was rewiring a house with the electricity turned on. That sounds right to me.

Does this sound right to you? If the Book of Acts is describing a church that we want to be like, that is a church that is full of the Holy Spirit. (AUDIENCE – amen) The full of the gifts of power. (AUDIENCE – yes) If you took away the miracles and gifts of power from the Book of Acts, there would be no more Book of Acts, right? It would just go straight to Romans.

Look, if we want to be like that, we need to walk in the Spirit. Derek Prince said church history is 1800 years of the church trying to create a system that is so safe that we don't need to rely on the Holy Spirit anymore. I don't want that system. Do you? (AUDIENCE – no) I want to know the Lord. And in fact, Dallas Willard, my father in the faith, said the same thing, that when he was growing up in Missouri, when electricity came to his town, nobody trusted it and very few people wanted it. But once they got it, they knew what they were missing.

How many in the church are that way with the Holy Spirit today? They want everything. They want the building and the windows and the kitchen and everything, but they're fine with kerosene. Who here is fine with kerosene? (AUDIENCE – no) I want the Holy Spirit. (AUDIENCE – yes) Wire my house, Lord. Amen? Bring the Holy Spirit. I want to walk in power, not in my strength, but in the power of God. Amen? (AUDIENCE – amen)

We want to begin here. Be led by your friend, the Holy Spirit in all things. That's not a ridiculous statement. When we say all things, we mean all things. When you're shopping, when you're driving, when you're talking, when you're thinking, when you're on your phone, be led by the Holy Spirit in all things.

Here's why: the scripture says those who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God. Maybe we can assert from that those who are not led by the Holy Spirit are not children of God. Is that true? Maybe. Those who are led by the Spirit are children of God, the scripture says. John 16 says, "The Holy Spirit will guide you into all things." The Holy Spirit will guide you in all things, not some things. How many things? (AUDIENCE – all things) John 14 says, "The Holy Spirit will show you and teach you all things." Somebody say all things. (AUDIENCE – all things) Is In-n-Out considered all things? (AUDIENCE – yes) What about when you put your shoes on? Is that included in all things? (AUDIENCE – yes) Now this sounds crazy to some people, but it's right on. It's where the power is.

Open your Bibles if you have it to Romans, chapter 8. All right, let's ask this question: how much condemnation is there for those who are in Christ Jesus? Let's find out. Are you ready? All right. "There is therefore now" somebody say no condemnation (AUDIENCE – "no condemnation"). If you're in Christ Jesus, there should be zero shame, guilt, self-deprecation. Self-mocking, self-belittling. That is an insult to God. If He did a good work in you, if He did a new creation in you, you are insulting the Lord. Don't do that. No condemnation. Right? And don't be condemned for condemning yourself. None!

Somebody put a smile on your face. There is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus because through Christ Jesus, the law of the Spirit who gives life, has set you free from the law of sin and death.

It doesn't end there. "For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a sin offering."

"And so he condemned sin in the flesh in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us who do not live according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit." What's that? That's the cross, right? It's all been paid for. "Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires, but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires."

This is a really important question. Is my mind set on what my body desires, what the world desires? Or is my mind constantly attuned to what the Holy Spirit desires, what He wants from me? Am I listening? Am I listening to Him?

And finally, it says, famously, “the mind governed by the flesh is (AUDIENCE – death), death,” death, spiritual death, physical death. “But the mind governed by the Spirit is (AUDIENCE – life) life and peace.”

Again, this is important. Paul, just before this, in Romans 7 says that the law is spiritual. The law is spiritual. And when we try to follow a law that is spiritual in a carnal way; that is with our mind rather than our spirit, we always fall short. He talks about, if you do it that way and you fall into legalism, you fall into religion. If it's all about rules, it's going to be death to you. You'll get worse, actually. You'll actually become worse. You'll create more laws because you can't fulfill those laws, so you'll create stricter laws, hoping that you won't violate the key laws. And this just will spin into itself until you have a religion spirit or a Pharisee spirit.

You cannot follow a spiritual law in a fleshly way. How do you follow a spiritual law? You do it in a spiritual way. In a spiritual way. He continues to say, not the.. it's called the antinomian heresy, which sometimes people interpret this as well then there is no law, there is no rules, there's no morals. Just grace covers it all. Do what you want. No, that's false.

Rather, when you walk in the Spirit, you understand the Spirit of the law, and you do the Spirit of the law. Is that right? You fulfill the law perfectly because you understand the heart of the Spirit of the law. This is not really what the sermon is about, but this is important.

Now one of the reasons we feel condemnation is because we're trying to obey a spiritual law through our flesh, through our personal strength, or even through our mind, rather than being led by the Holy Spirit. When you're led by the Holy Spirit in all things, you don't even want to sin anymore. It's just not interesting to you?

Okay? I know that might be hard for some to believe, but it is the truth. This is how you break chains. Where the Spirit of the Lord is (AUDIENCE – there is freedom) there is freedom. Amen! (AUDIENCE – amen) So you can't be flesh led, carnal led most of the time, and then switch to spiritual minds when you're supposed to be spiritual. That's what a lot of Christians are doing every day. They're worldly minded, they're flesh minded, they're doing things in their own strength on what they think are petty things. And then when they get to important things, it's like, okay, now I'm going to switch to my spiritual mind. Now I'm going to tune in. Now I'm going to catch the Lord. No, no, no. Is it some things or all things that the Holy Spirit will lead us in? (AUDIENCE – all things) He says it plainly that we're led in all things multiple times. All things, all things. We're Spirit led.

So this is the first. This is the first huge, huge unlock for you is to be spiritually minded all the time. I used to hear people say, don't be so spiritually minded you're no earthly good. Now that's funny, but I don't think I've ever seen that. I really don't think I've seen that. I've seen people who are religious, I've seen people who are phony, but I have never seen anybody who's so spiritually minded they're no earthly good. In fact, my experience is that the people who are spiritually minded are the most earthly good someone can be. Was Jesus spiritually minded all the time? (AUDIENCE – yes) Was He? (AUDIENCE – yes) Did Jesus pray a lot? (AUDIENCE – yes) A lot? (AUDIENCE – yes) If Jesus, the Son of God, prayed a lot, how much should I pray? (AUDIENCE – a lot) Someone say, a lot. I need it. What does this look like practically? I'll just give you an example. I felt like being led of the Spirit. I felt like the Holy Spirit said, tell them what you did last week. And when I reviewed the ways in which the Lord led me, just in this last week, I went, wow, that's actually really a good thing to share.

Early this week, said goodbye to Hannah and Haven on my way to work, got in the car, the Holy Spirit said, 'go back in and tell your wife you love her.' So I did, from the Lord. Got up, said, I love you. Said, I love you, too. Give her a hug. Is that a good thing or a bad thing? (AUDIENCE – good thing) If I missed it, is that okay? (SOME AUDIENCE – no) It is okay.

If I missed it, and I went and told my wife I love her, is that a bad thing? (AUDIENCE – no) That's not a bad thing, right? And I didn't miss it. He told me.

One time this last week, I felt the Lord say to me, Bobby, put your phone down, and He put somebody on my heart to pray for. And then I said, all right. And very often I'll text someone after I pray for them. I said, Lord, should I text them and tell them, no, don't text them. You just trust that, right? I don't know why. I don't need to know why. I follow the Lord.

At the cafe where I go every morning, I was actually reading my Bible and the Lord said, stop reading your Bible. Look up. Someone's going to talk to you. So I waited about three minutes. Sure enough, this guy came in and he wanted to talk to me about the Lord. Someone I had talked to weeks ago. Is that the Lord or not? (AUDIENCE – yes) That's the Lord. Isn't that great?

Listen, you guys are going to hate this one, but I went to the food court at Fashion Island to get some Chick-fil-A, the Lord's chicken. Amen? And the Lord said, sit here. Like all these tables, and I wasn't paying attention. The Lord said, sit here. What did I do? Sat there and I ate my chicken. And sure enough, I had my Bible out. This is a sign that you're a believer. This couple walked by. Denise and her husband came. They said, what are you doing? I said, I'm eating chicken and reading my Bible. And they began to talk to me about the Lord. And she talked to me about some blood clots and some trials she was facing, and the Lord said to me, ask her if you can heal her. And in my mind, I'm going, Lord, you're the great physician. Not me. And He said, no, no, no. I told you to heal them. Did He tell us to heal? (AUDIENCE – yes) Think about that for a minute.

In Mark, chapter 16, "you shall lay hands on the sick, and they'll be made well." Matthew, chapter 10, He says, "you go heal the sick, you go raise the dead, you go cast out demons." Do you heal? In a way you do. Now without the Lord, you have no power. Without the Spirit, you're powerless. You deserve none of the glory. Right? The glory is from the Lord. But I know that was hard for me. And He said, ask her, can I heal you? She's a believer. And what came out was, can I heal you and pray for you? That's the best I could do, because this is hard for me. And the Lord did not hold that against me. It was fine and I prayed for her.

These are all ways in the last week. Can you see that by having a line to the Holy Spirit, do you see how I don't need to be in a corner with a bullhorn? People come to me. I said, people come to me. People will come to you if you're full of the Holy Spirit. We're all spiritual. We're all spiritual beings, whether we're saved or not. All of us. And we know when we sense goodness and light. And we know when we sense darkness and evil, and people that are suffering and starving spiritually, if you are a flame and full of life, they'll just kind of get close to you. Is that right?

This is where the miracles happen. The miracles don't happen when we're carnally minded sometimes and spiritually minded other times. The miracles happen when we're available to God all the time and we constantly have that line going. It sounds taxing to some of you, but that is a lie from the enemy. It is freedom, I'm telling you. It is freedom. You already have a line of communication with someone all the time. How about we keep it in line with the God of peace and life and freedom? Amen? (AUDIENCE – amen) And holiness. Real quick, the Spirit leading us is like a nudging, a stopping, a word which is felt like knowledge, not an actual word. It's a stamp, or its peace. You have peace about a choice you made. And when you're trying to be led and you're stepping out in faith, you're going to miss it sometimes. You're going to miss it sometimes, and sometimes you'll catch it. And you want to begin to decipher the signal from the noise, and that's where the miracles happen.

I came up with this today. Forgive me, it's a little corny, but how do we confirm that it's the Holy Spirit? Does it BOP? All right, it BOPS! Somebody look at your neighbor and say, it BOPS. (AUDIENCE – it BOPS) Okay, number one. B is for what?

(AUDIENCE – Bible) Is it against scripture or for scripture? If it aligns with scripture, it's good. If it's in any way against the scripture, it's not bopping. It doesn't BOP.

Number two, it's the outcome. Jesus says you'll know them by their fruit. Right? If you are led by the Lord and it causes division and it harms people or causes loss or whatever, strife. No. Right? If it bears good fruit, love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, health, provision, it's from the Lord.

Number three is the peace in it. Peace. If you're doing something and the peace departs from you, the peace of the Holy Spirit, that's a good indicator that the Holy Spirit is not in the thing that you're doing.

Number four is saints in agreement. Not other Christians, okay? Don't ask all Christians because 90% of Christians are not walking in the Spirit, just to be honest with you. Ask the saints. Ask the believers that you know are hearing from God. You think that's from the Lord, and you'll get a confirmation, usually.

Somebody look at your neighbor and say, it BOPS (AUDIENCE – it BOPS). One more time. Bible - B is for Bible. B is for Bible. O is for outcome. P is for peace. Oh, you're cheating now. S is for saints in agreement.

Again, should I really be Spirit led in all things, church? (AUDIENCE – yes) What about when you're ordering at Starbucks? Should you be led by the Spirit there at Starbucks? (AUDIENCE – yes) Now, here's a good question. Why? Why be led by the Holy Spirit when you're ordering at Starbucks? See, too many of you have a closed mind. You don't understand the incredible opportunity that's made available to you when you're ordering at Starbucks. And somebody's like, no, I'm not talking about the array of drinks, and there's many delicious drinks at Starbucks. I just get a black coffee. There's no calories. And a lot of caffeine.

If you're ordering a Starbucks and you're listening to the Spirit, you might see a hurting person that you need to minister to. The Holy Spirit might tell you to order an extra coffee or sandwich for a homeless person you're going to see later. What if that's true? Or to get a gift card to hand out to a guy that's flying signs on the road so he can get lunch later. So is it good to listen to the Holy Spirit when I'm ordering at Starbucks? (AUDIENCE – yes) In all times. We don't see what the Lord sees unless we're dialed in. Amen?

(AUDIENCE – amen) And I'm just telling you that the more you do this, you continue to invite into your life just the victory and just a relaxed spirit, that you just feel more relaxed and not tense and not hurried. And you're just accomplishing and having victory. Who wants that life? (AUDIENCE – amen) Where the spirit of the Lord is, there's freedom. The life led by the Spirit is an open life. I'm open, Lord. I'm not just open when I'm spiritual, I'm always spiritual. I'm always open. Amen? (AUDIENCE – amen) And if you're open and you're watching on YouTube, we really do appreciate it when you subscribe, so please consider subscribing and following us. Thank you.

We're going to go a little deeper. Here's a stumbling block for some. When you're not intentionally trying to hear from the Holy Spirit, you're consistently interrupted by demonic forces assigned to you. There are demonic forces assigned to you. They're working on you.

I learned this at an early age when I read C.S. Lewis's book *The Screwtape Letters*. It paints a great picture about how the spiritual life is really a military life. That you've got two military forces, good and evil, fighting against one another that have levels of command and authority within those planes. And how you have demonic forces assigned to you to distract you. They are powerless unless you give them power, by the way, completely powerless. But they don't seem powerless. They're very scary, right? They're very this, they're very that. And when you're not dialed into the Lord, it is easy for you to go into a rage, to go into doubt, to go into despair.

Anything with a voice is a person. One more time. Anything with a voice. Anything with a voice. Anything with a voice is a person.

If you're hearing in a knowledge way, the same way that a spirit speaks to us in knowledge, if you're hearing in a knowledge way from a voice, it's a demon. Here's what demonic voices sound like. Here's what demonic interruptions sound like. The 'what if' voice. What if your children die? What if he's or she's cheating on you? What if you get fired? What if the economy crashes? These kinds of things. This 'what if' voice is the voice of fear. This is the worry voice, the fear voice. Okay?

Second voice slander. Slander them, gossip about them, rival them, envy them. This is a violence voice. A violence voice. It's a voice that in your heart wants to cause harm, and it's from the enemy.

There's another voice that says you need to lie, you need to exaggerate, hide this key thing. That's a deception voice. Very common. And final one, the voice that says, you're going to die. You're going to lose. Nothing matters. It's all this. It's all fake. Nothing that's important. That's a despair voice. Okay? Who recognizes some of these voices? Don't give it a live voice. Who recognizes some of these voices? (AUDIENCE – yes) These are voices that have spoken.. all of these have spoken to me many times, and they're not from you. You slap them down. That's what brother Keith Moore, right? Somebody say slap it down. (AUDIENCE – slap it down) You slap it down. It is not your thought. It is not from your body. It is not from you. It's from an outside force trying to make you carnally minded. And when you're spiritually minded, the volume on those other voices goes way down. Way down and you continue to slap it down.

Declare with me: my ears are my ears (AUDIENCE – my ears are my ears). I'll hear what I hear (AUDIENCE – I'll hear what I hear). My eyes are my eyes (AUDIENCE – my eyes are my eyes). I'll look at what I want to look at (AUDIENCE – I'll look at what I want to look at). My mind is my mind (AUDIENCE – my mind is my mind). I will think about what I want to think about (AUDIENCE – I will think about what I want to think about). Amen (AUDIENCE – amen).

If the slapping it down doesn't work, just start worshiping the Lord. (AUDIENCE – yes) It's like nails down a chalkboard for the enemy. It works. It works. Put your favorite worship song on and sing along. Sing it loud, sing it proud. Stick your hands in the air, jump up and down and shout. I said it this morning, but Psalm 8, verse 2 says that when we praise God, it silences the enemy. Is it true or not true? (AUDIENCE – it's true) It creates a stronghold against the enemy. And we can hear from the Lord.

The more you silence the enemy, the less he can get his message to you. Isn't that good? And just life and peace. To be carnally minded is death. To be spiritually minded is life and peace. Amen? (AUDIENCE – amen) And actually, the more you do that and the more whatever demonic forces are assigned to you can't get into your head anymore, you will literally have demonized people sent your way because if he can't talk to you, he'll talk through someone else that's being demonized to get to you. You'll hear it all the time. If you really listen to what people say, you go, that is the voice of the enemy. They're just giving voice to the enemy.

Actually, in my life, the more Hannah and I have been waging war against Satan, healing the sick, casting out demons, the more I have seen people randomly, just this last month, randomly manifesting in my life because I'm not listening anymore to the enemy. We were driving down the road down Irvine Boulevard. I had not changed a lane in, like, five minutes. I was just driving straight at a normal pace, slightly 5/10 miles over speed limit. That's normal. If you go THE speed limit, you're crazy. The limit is on the bottom part. See, that's the minimum.

But anyway, no but I'm driving along and this guy in a hybrid behind me just started doing this and riding me and going like this. And then he went into the bike lane. Like, I don't remember doing anything. Now I drive a white Camry, so maybe he got me confused with somebody else, but he came alongside in the bike lane, is flipping me off and cursing at me. And Hannah immediately goes, that's a demon. She goes, just slow down.

Just slow down. Let him go. I slowed down. You know me, I want to fight. I slow down. Like, you're right, just whatever. And I'm not worried about it. He pulls ahead and he slams on his brakes. And of course, we're really.. so we're just.. she's like, Bobby, just slow down. I'm like, okay, slow down. We're going real slow. Then he completely stops on this highway, and we're behind him, so we kind of like, blinker, kind of go around him. Then he does the same thing, pulls alongside us, cursing, yelling like this, and pulls in front of us and brake checks us again. We're like, what is going on? We literally didn't do anything. And it's just a demon.

Sometimes people get upset and they flip you off. That's just an angry person, right? We call it the angry bird. Angry bird? This was not an angry bird. There was a man who was being demonized that was trying to get me fired up so I'd make some stupid mistake, and gratefully, my wife was there.

Forgive me for this description, but also, about a month ago, I'm stopped at a red light. There's four cars. One in the left turn lane, three in the forward lane. Four cars were all lined up, facing the same direction. A heavyset, older homeless lady is walking across the road. She stops in front of my car, looks up at me and starts going, "F you." Right? I'm like, whoa. The light turns green. Cars are still stopped because there's a person in the crosswalk and starts going "f", like, manifesting, right? "F you!" Like this.

I look at the people next to me. There's a guy here and a gal there, and they look at me and I go.. and then she.. forgive me, but she starts flipping me off, and then she begins to start choking herself, like she's going to throw up. She's trying to make herself throw up. And this is just going on, and it's going on for a couple minutes, and I'm just like, Lord, what do you want me to do? And then there's a police officer who starts to come. This is all in front of my car. She's just looking at me. Nobody else except for me, and then she sees a police officer and she starts to move along. And who here knows that was a demon? If you begin to shut the enemy out mentally, that's a good thing, but he is a persistent cuss. Isn't that right, Hannah? He will send someone to try and get you off track. Somebody here maybe is asking a question, why didn't you get out and cast out the demon from that lady? Can I just tell you? I asked the Holy Spirit, and He said, don't do it. And in fact, many cases when people are being demonized like that, they're in agreement with the unclean spirit. God does not set you free from your friends, He sets you free from your enemies. You cannot be in agreement with an unclean spirit and want it cast out. You have to hate it. Does that make sense?

Can I go a little longer? I know I'm kind of dwelling on this, but I don't get angry at that. I don't get fearful. In fact, I'm honored. They know who I am. The demons know who I am. You remember in the Gospels, they knew who Jesus was in the first chapter. Took the disciples three years to figure it out. They knew immediately who He was. They see me, they see you. That's Jesus' brother. That's his little brother. And what do we do? Somebody say, ha. (AUDIENCE – ha) So now say, ha ha (AUDIENCE – ha, ha). Who cares? Not my monkey, not my zoo, not my problem. Amen? I'm spiritually minded. I just follow the Lord.

Final thought, I promise. If you're truly led by the Holy Spirit, the world won't love you anymore. Okay? If you're really led by the Holy Spirit in all things, the world is not going to love you anymore. You're going to lose some friends if you haven't been. But it will need you. They won't love you, but they'll need you more than ever. There are a lot of Christians that won't love you if you're spiritually minded, because they're carnally minded, too. But they'll need you. They'll need you. Amen?

Dietrich Bonhoeffer said there's a cost to discipleship, and he paid the price. He died in concentration camps as a pastor defending the Jews in the Holocaust. There's a cost to discipleship. Sometimes the cost is our lives. No soldier who signs up for war thinks in his mind, I don't agree to die. Some of them will have to lay down their lives. Amen? And part of the cost that we'll pay in America is the world won't love us anymore.

Might cost us some money. It might cost you some work. Might cost you some friends. They'll call your standards judgment or prudishness, or they'll call your standards toxic. They'll call your lack of agitation and worry all the time. They'll think you don't care. If you pray for miracles, sometimes people will get mad at you. Don't give them hope. Don't give them hope. What's that sound like?

These are all true. These are all things that I face daily, and Hannah, and many of you face daily. That there is a cost to discipleship, and that is that the world won't love you anymore. Somebody say, who cares. (AUDIENCE – who cares) Because you know what? There is a cost to non-discipleship, too. There is a cost to non-discipleship. That cost is everything.

Here's what non-discipleship looks like: stressed out, no victory, no life, no food, no purpose. Having all the money in the world, having means but no meaning. Having a life that's lifeless. That is the cost of non-discipleship. That is the cost of not being led and not living in the Spirit. Amen? (AUDIENCE – amen)

Declare with me, church. My food (AUDIENCE – my food) is to do the will (AUDIENCE – is to do the will) of Him who sent me (AUDIENCE – of Him who sent me) and to finish His work (AUDIENCE – and to finish His work). Amen (AUDIENCE – amen).

Repeat after me, church: I decide (AUDIENCE – I decide) today (AUDIENCE – today) to be spirit led (AUDIENCE – to be spirit led) in all things (AUDIENCE – in all things). I'm listening (AUDIENCE – I'm listening) your sheep (AUDIENCE – your sheep) hear your voice (AUDIENCE – hear your voice). I hear your voice (AUDIENCE – I hear your voice) and I thank you, Lord (AUDIENCE – and I thank you Lord) in Jesus name (AUDIENCE – in Jesus name), Amen (AUDIENCE – amen). Thank you, Lord. Amen.
