BS: Amen! This is the day the Lord has made. We will rejoice and be glad in it. Hello! (AUDIENCE - good morning). Ready for a special day today? Who here knows it's Pentecost Sunday? He is just a generous, just a kind, loving, full of energy, full of the Holy Spirit, and he's going to bless you. Let's stand on our feet. Let's welcome David Diga Hernandez to the house! Amen! David!

MESSAGE/PRAYER – David Diga Hernandez "The Baptism with the Holy Spirit"

Can we give the Lord a hand of praise today? Give Jesus a hand of praise today.

I'm so thankful for the opportunity to be able to serve you here this morning, and I want to thank my friend's pastors Bobby and Hannah for allowing me this opportunity. I just want to say this: I share this story every time he and I interact on some type of media piece, but I used to do some hosting for a youth network. It was a subsidiary of TBN, J.C. TV, and we would have various different guests coming in from all different parts of the world, and different representations of ministries. And you know how it is when you do media or television, sometimes, and if you don't know, sometimes they say never meet your heroes because there are certain individuals who portray themselves to be one way, and then when you meet them, they're really mean.

This wasn't always the case, but it was very busy, very business, very fast-paced, and that's not to say the network itself was like that, but that was just the nature of how you did media production. I remember what stood out most when I first met Pastor Bobby is that he was just so kind to everyone. And that's what struck me.

I mean we'd had people who came and demonstrated amazing prophetic gifts, great teachers, some end-time prophecy teachers, very interesting guests, but to me that always stood out because I remember I was very nervous even when I was hosting because I was just getting the hang of it. Pastor Bobby comes along and he's not only talking to me and the other hosts, he's talking to the camera people and the people at craft service.

I just want you to know, I know you already know it, but I want to say it and affirm it: this is an amazing couple and you have a very dynamic Jesus-loving kind couple pastoring here. Pastor Bobby, thank you for your friendship, thank you for your kindness, and thank you for being like Jesus. That's a refreshing thing to see.

I want to pray before we begin because I want to talk to you about the baptism with the Holy Spirit. Would you all please just close your eyes, lift your hands, and let's welcome the influence of the Holy Spirit. So precious Lord Jesus, we thank you for the gift of the Holy Spirit. Holy Spirit, I ask that you would begin to work on our hearts. Speak to us and challenge us as only you can. Father, let us leave here saying today what a wonderful Jesus we serve. Holy Spirit, cause us to be more in love with Jesus than we've ever been. Cause us to be more like Jesus than we've ever been. Begin to chisel away at mindsets and attitudes and compromise that's not of you. Refine us as gold in a fire. By your Word and by your spirit, in the mighty name of Jesus we pray, and all who believed it declared, amen (AUDIENCE – amen).

I grew up in church. I'm a fourth generation Christian, third generation preacher. And growing up I knew Jesus socially, because my family was Christian, I knew Jesus historically, because I had read about Him in scripture, and I knew Jesus philosophically because I was familiar with His teachings. I memorized the verses, I attended Sunday school. But I didn't know Jesus personally.

What I began to share a few years ago more publicly was that for several years I battled heavily with anxiety and depression. And when I was a little boy, the attacks were demonic. My mind was under assault. I can remember, even at the age of seven, sensing this weighty feeling of depression, this sadness and this anxiety and this torment of the mind. I would have terrible nightmares and I would see demonic activity and the enemy would harass my mind. It was spiritual warfare, and even at a young age I could sense the conflict over my soul; light versus darkness, angels versus demons, heaven versus hell. And that tension was what I lived in. Now even as a little boy, I understood some of the spiritual dynamics. Again, I grew up in a Christian home. Now here's what troubled me - my dad was a pastor, but here I was suffering in my mind and in my heart.

And so this began to intensify until it came to this culmination where I finally said to myself, I have to get saved. And here's the thing is even at the age of 7, 8, 9, and now I'm 11-years-old at this point, wanting to give my life to Jesus. That's how long it went on for.

Eleven years old. Even at that age I had this stubbornness in me because here's the thing, I had identified myself as the guy who never missed Sunday school, the one who memorized all the scriptures, the one who was always very well behaved. And because of that, I had developed, even at that age, this great deal of pride. There was religious pride. Here's the thing about religious mindset says that religion will keep you from experiencing the real thing because then you have to admit that what you've had up unto that point was a counterfeit. I didn't want to admit that. But I knew it in my heart to be true.

Finally my family goes to a Bible conference. It was a week-long Bible conference. Now if you grow up as a pastor's kid, then Bible conferences double as the family vacation. So there we were, five of us: my mom, my dad, my older sister, my younger brother crammed in one room, and I remember going to the day sessions during the Bible conference, and I remember one session in particular. I'm standing in the back holding onto the chair, gripping it because of the anxiety. I'm watching all of the people in the congregation dancing around and celebrating and shouting and praising God, and they all seem so joy filled.

I remember I was so jealous of what they had that it made me angry. And I'm standing there going, why can't I be like that? You ever seen other people have their encounters with God? Tell their testimony? You become frustrated because you feel left out. You're wondering what did they do right? What am I doing wrong? Are they just special, called, favored, and maybe I'm just not. Maybe God selected them for those types of experiences, or maybe God selected them to be so close to Him. But me, I'm just one that's supposed to be on the outskirts, distant from God, always wondering when He's speaking to me. Never really experiencing the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit is not a reward for the super spiritual. I think we think about Him in those terms sometimes where He's off at a distance and the better we perform, the closer He gets. But the Holy Spirit is not a reward for the super spiritual. There's no such thing as the super spiritual. The Holy Spirit is the only chance that any of us have at being spiritual. In fact, He's the only reason you desire to be close to God is because the Holy Spirit gives you that desire.

There I am watching the people dance, sing, shout. I go back to the room and I'm just angry. Eleven years old. And then my family goes to the next session. I didn't want to go. I stood behind in the hotel room. I said, I'm just going to stay here. So they all went to the other session. And as I'm lying there on the bed in the hotel room by myself, I'm staring at the ceiling and that familiar torment begins to harass my mind. Anxiety so bad that my body began to tremble, I began to sweat, visions and flashes of thoughts of hell and torment and demonic activity filling my mind. Dread coming over me. And I'm just lying there in that torment. And I determined right then and there, I need to give my life. I need to get right. I need to give my life to Jesus.

My family comes back in. I asked my dad, can I speak to you? I think he could see on my face that there was something different about me, something wrong. So he sends the rest of the family away, comes into the room. This was a hotel with two beds. I sat on one facing the other. My dad sat on the other side facing me, and he put his hands out and he began to lead me in a prayer. Now, I know there are those who kind of nitpick and say, well there's no such thing as the sinner's prayer in the Bible, and we can acknowledge that to some degree, but in the Bible you will find sinners who pray. And Paul did write about confession corresponding with the salvation experience.

And so there I am praying, my father's leading me in this prayer, and I remember my mouth was shaking so violently because I was so overwhelmed with the feeling of love and peace that I couldn't even say the prayer. I could feel the warmth of my tears falling down my face. And as I'm trying to say this prayer, I can't get the words out. My body's shaking, but this time it's not from torment. I'm feeling bursts of, yes, euphoric-like love and peace and joy, like a well was breaking loose, like a dam was breaking, and I was being flooded by this sense of divine closeness. And I remember just thinking over and over and over as I'm saying this prayer, I'm about to meet Him. I'm going to meet Jesus. The one I read about, the one they talked about, the one I learned of in Sunday school. I'm going to meet Jesus. Him. He's coming here.

I remember that I sensed that presence of the Lord come into the room, the manifested presence, meaning I was aware of Him in the room with me. And the very moment that Jesus walked in, every demon ran out. It was the presence of the Holy Spirit. And so from then on, I began to develop this hunger to know the things of God. And I began reading scripture. I was praying four to eight hours a day, reading 20, 30, 40 chapters of the Bible. Now, I want to be clear here because I don't want to create any unrealistic expectations. Keep in mind, I was 11-years-old. I didn't have a job, a family. I wasn't married. I didn't have kids. You're a single mom watching this, saying, well, I can't commit to that. Or maybe you're a father who's just working all the time, just trying to make ends meet, and you're saying, where am I going to find four to eight hours? It's okay.

The Lord understands our situations, and we do have certain obligations that the Lord understands we have to meet. This was just that season in my life for me. I took advantage of my youth in that way.

I remember doing this, and I sensed this spiritual momentum. I'm watching Christian television. I'm watching Hour of Power. I'm watching Praise the Lord. I'm watching all these different preachers and teachers, and I'm reading the books and I'm getting the content, and I remember just sensing this swift movement to my spirituality. There's this momentum that I'm sensing.

I would even go out to lunch with the guest speakers. Because my dad was the pastor, I was able to go to lunch with the guest speakers. And I remember just sitting at lunch with them, pestering them with question after question after question on prophecy, deliverance, healing, the Holy Spirit, the Bible. You name it, I was asking it. And notes and piles of notes.

And then all of a sudden, from seemingly nowhere, I felt like I hit this brick wall. And immediately, this is what's so interesting, I go back to my religious thinking. What did I do wrong? Did I make God angry? Did I pray something wrong? Did I not pray enough? Did I not get enough chapters of the Bible today in? Did I miss too many services? Because I was at every revival meeting, worship experience, Bible seminar, prophetic gathering, you name it. If the doors were open, I was in the church, but maybe I didn't attend enough meetings.

And so now I begin this pursuit. And this is where things really began to change for me and where I really began to learn what the baptism with the Holy Spirit was. And so I say to the Lord, I said, Lord, I'm going to lock myself in the room, and I'm not coming out till I have an encounter with you. Now, I'm going to be honest with you, I didn't even know what I meant by "encounter" when I said that. I didn't know what I was looking for. But I locked my door. I remember I turned on my ceiling fan, I turn on the light. My room got a little warm, so I turn on the fan, I turn on the light so I can see. I laid my Bible out on the desk with the highlighters. I had the worship music on. If Instagram existed then, it would have made a perfect Instagram post. And I begin to pray.

You ever hear those stories of people who pray for hours and you wonder, what did you say the whole time? That was me then at that point, because I had hit that brick wall, there wasn't that flow anymore. I remember just worshipping for hours, but now there was something blocking this flow. And so I pray for that first hour and nothing happens. No heavenly encounter, no angelic visitation, no direction from the Lord, no prophetic unction, nothing.

I say, okay, now I'm going to get real serious here. And I begin to try to tap into my emotions, which is from the soul. There's your body - your earth suit, your soul - your mind, will, emotions and personality, and then your spirit - your direct connection with God. And so now I'm praying from the soul. I'm trying to use emotion. God, don't you hear me? God, can't you see me? God, why aren't you responding? I'm trying to guilt Him into a response, thinking my tears can twist His arm. And I give everything I have with emotion. Two hours go by, nothing happens.

I say, okay, I'm really, really, really now going to try to make this happen. I get aggressive. I start thinking of all the spiritual warfare techniques I had read of: the rebuking of demons, the conquering of hell, the calling upon of angels, the drawing of the bloodline of Christ and claiming it, and all of this, and these are wonderful truths, but I wasn't using them in the way that the Bible teaches us to use them. I was using them in a ritualistic, systematic way, and I thought that if I could follow a script, I'd get a response.

And so here I am rebuking anything and everything. Some of the demons probably didn't even exist, but I would take an adjective, attach it to a demon and rebuke it. The spirit of distraction in prayer, the spirit of this and the spirit of that; aggression, anger, technique. That third hour went by. Nothing happened.

And now I'm starting to regret my ultimatum. I said, okay, now I'm going to figure my way into the presence. Now I'm reaching for theology and I try to think of all the different things I had read of prayer and the presence and the Greek and the Hebrew and you name it, it was all going through my mind. Four hours go by. Intellect failed, too. It's not by power, nor by might, but by my Spirit, saith the Lord. You cannot cause a spiritual encounter through carnal means.

And so now I'm frustrated. I did the best thing I did up unto that point - I gave up. I remember I had my hands lifted. I was frustrated. Remember, I had experienced this wonderful, personal revival. And now here I was, feeling like God was a million miles away. I felt you. I heard you. I knew you. I sensed you near. And now here I am, begging for just a scrap, it seemed. And I said, I don't know how to pray. I don't know how to find Jesus. Please help me find Jesus.

And a gentle whisper comes, telling me to turn off my fan. I thought it was odd, but I did it, and I realized the fan was making a bunch of noise. Turn off the light. I did it. I was too focused on my surroundings. I had read dozens of chapters of the Bible that day, so for now, the instruction was to close the book. I did. And then I heard the final instruction: turn off the music. And this was my initial reaction. I said, but you can't move without the music. I didn't say it like that, but that was my reaction, that hesitation. But I turned it off. I stood there, hands lifted, eyes closed, just waiting for what I did not know.

And it was like someone took my room and lifted it to a heavenly place. The plain, ordinary settings of my bedroom became divine. And I'm standing there with eyes closed, hands lifted, and I began to sense again those bursts of joy and peace and love and power. I felt heat come upon my physical body and electric-like pulses moving up and down. And I felt so loved, so accepted, I didn't want to move. And the presence of Jesus became so real to me, I thought if I were to open my eyes, I'd see Him looking right back at me. I thought if I would move my hand, I'd feel it brush up against His robe. I didn't open my eyes right then and there. I didn't see Him there physically, but I knew He was with me.

Now that encounter, if you want to call it that, lasted for just a few seconds, maybe minutes, but had I sought it for a hundred years, those few moments would have been worth it. They marked me and changed me.

And here's what I learned about the Holy Spirit in that moment. You see, many believers seek the Holy Spirit as if they don't have Him. Romans 8:9 teaches us that if you don't have the Holy Spirit, you're not a child of God. Therefore, you can't be a child of God without the Holy Spirit. Ephesians 1:13 and 14 teach us that we are sealed unto salvation by the Holy Spirit. John chapter 3, Jesus tells us that the Holy Spirit is involved in the process of salvation. First Corinthians 6:17 says, he that is joined to the Lord is one Spirit with Him, therefore we have that union with Him.

You see, it's not that I earned the Holy Spirit through prayer, and a lot of people misunderstand the story. They think, oh, so the formula is, pray for four hours, get an encounter, work yourself into a frenzy, get God to respond, torture yourself enough and God will be pleased enough to give you His Holy Spirit.

And we say things like, I need more power, I need more love, I need more gifts. My friend, Romans chapter 8, verse 11 tells us that the same Spirit who raised Christ from the dead dwells in you, not in smaller measures, not in lesser portions, but in the fullness of His power He comes to dwell in you at the moment of salvation. The same Holy Spirit who hovered above the face of the deep when Father spoke His Word to cause all creation to come into existence.

The same Holy Spirit who inspired the workers on the tabernacle to craft the various items that they might be done with excellence. The same Holy Spirit who caused Joseph to interpret dreams. The same Holy Spirit who inspired within the heart of David poetic stanzas of worship. The same Holy Spirit who gave wisdom to Solomon. The same Holy Spirit who gave oracles to the prophets concerning the Christ.

The same Holy Spirit who rested upon the disciples. The same Holy Spirit who in John 20:22 was breathed upon the church by Christ Himself. The same Holy Spirit who came upon Jesus that He might set the captives free and declare the Gospel. That same Holy Spirit, nothing lacking, lives in you. The fullness of His power.

Therefore, we do not pray TO connect with God, we pray FROM connection with God. We do not work FOR union with God, we work FROM union with God. How much time would you save yourself? How much heartache would you save yourself if instead of begging God to hear you, you simply believe that He already did? You don't have to persuade Him. You don't have to convince Him. You don't have to beg Him. He dwells in in you.

First Corinthians, chapter 2, verses 9 through 16. "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him." This is not speaking about later, a then and there, this is here and now. We know that because in verse 10 the scripture declares, "But it was to us that God revealed these things by his Spirit. For his Spirit searches out everything and shows us God's deep secrets. No one can know a person's thoughts except that person's own spirit. And no one can know God's thoughts except God's own spirit.

We have received God's spirit, not the world's spirit, so we can know the wonderful things God has freely given us. When we tell you these things, we do not use words that come from human wisdom. Instead we speak words given to us by the Spirit, using the Spirit's words to explain spiritual truths. But people who aren't spiritual can't receive these truths from God's Spirit. It all sounds foolish to them and they can't understand it.

For only those who are spiritual can understand what the Spirit means. Those who are spiritual can evaluate all things, but they themselves cannot be evaluated by others. For who can know the Lord's thoughts? Who knows enough to teach them, but we understand these things for we have the mind of Christ" deep calling unto deep, the Holy Spirit searching out the deep things of God. He knows His power, His wisdom, His plans, His nature, and He communes with you, revealing it to you.

In your Spirit, you already know God. In your spirit, you're already connected with Him. In your Spirit, you already have peace. In your Spirit, you already have love and joy and boldness and holiness and clarity of mind. That's all there, readily available. It's all a matter now of surrendering and that's what the baptism with the Holy Spirit is.

You see, you are baptized with the Holy Spirit when you are born again, but it's not just a well, it's also a river. It's not just a one-time experience, it's a continual state of being.

You receive Him at salvation, you release Him for the rest of your life. At salvation He fills you like water in a cup. For the rest of your life, He fills you like wind in a sail. Ephesians 5:18 tells us to be filled with the Holy Spirit. And the phrase there in the original language is speaking of a continual state of being. It's a constant flow from which we receive.

The way you experience the Holy Spirit's power is not by getting more of the Holy Spirit. You don't need to get more of the Holy Spirit. So it's not a matter of you getting more of Him, it's a matter of Him getting more of you. Surrendering, yielding, giving to Him those areas of your heart to which you are clinging stubbornly. Areas maybe where you experience pain and hurt, doubt and confusion. Maybe you're afraid to believe because you don't want to get your hopes up only to see them not met again. But the Holy Spirit is waiting for you.

John 7:38, Jesus says, "Out of your innermost being will flow rivers of living water." That means from the Spirit comes the flow of His influence. You have the Holy Spirit, but does He have every aspect of you?

My prayer here is that we would experience the baptism with the Holy Spirit through surrender. Therefore, the baptism with the Holy Spirit is not rain from above, it's a flood from within. And once that begins to break, those waters begin to flow. That love, joy, peace, all that He is flowing from within, affecting the soul, and when those flood waters reach the soul, it comes forth as joy and peace and hope and clarity.

And when those flood waters reach the body, it's healing, its deliverance, its prophecy, its tongues, it's the sense of the glory of God on your being.

Think of the three expressions of the manifestation of God's presence. There is the omnipresence of God everywhere at all times, the indwelling presence of God, the Holy Spirit in you, and the manifested presence of God. Well, the omnipresence of God is God's awareness of everything. The manifested presence of God is your awareness of Him. That's why in certain moments you can sense Him closer. It's not that He comes and goes, it's that you become more and less aware. So when we worship, it's not Him coming closer, it's us becoming more aware. Same is true of prayer.

If you want to experience the influence of the Holy Spirit, it's a matter of living in the awareness of and responsiveness to the Holy Spirit within you. The flood waters are there to experience the baptism. Simply remove the blockages. And as you remove those blockages, He begins to affect the different aspects of your being.

Holy Spirit, I pray that you would give us the ability to surrender. Precious Holy Spirit, these are your people. Call them into deeper waters, I pray. Take them to higher heights, I pray. Cause us to become so aware of Jesus that He becomes more real to us than anything else around us that we experience in this life. We surrender.

I want to take a moment now to pray over you. If you're saying yes, I recognize I have the Holy Spirit, but I want to experience the baptism with the Holy Spirit afresh, allow those flood waters to move. There are blockages in your life that you want to see unblocked, greater measures untapped, potential untold. And you're saying, I just want to respond to that. Then may I ask that you come and stand at this altar now. Stand up out of your seat and come. I want to pray over as many of you as I can. Come and stand if that's you. Don't wait to see whose coming. Don't look around to see if the altars fill up or not. If that's you, you stand and you come.

I also want to invite those who are believing God for healing, for deliverance, for a breakthrough. Fresh waters flowing. Fresh waters flowing. That's the presence of the Holy Ghost here. That's the presence of the Holy Ghost. I give you the praise, Jesus.

If you're down here at the front altar, I want you to lift your hands now. Say Holy Spirit (AUDIENCE – Holy Spirit). Come on, say it boldly. Holy Spirit (AUDIENCE – Holy Spirit), I surrender (AUDIENCE – I surrender). Holy Spirit (AUDIENCE – Holy Spirit) fill me afresh (AUDIENCE – fill me afresh) in Jesus name (AUDIENCE – in Jesus name).

Now, in this moment, I want you to just forget about who's around you. Forget that I'm even here. Forget that you're here at church and just begin to let Him work on you. Yield, yield, yield to those areas. Give Him the un-forgiveness. Give Him the secret sin. Give Him the pride. Give Him the doubt. Give Him the confusion. Give Him the feeling of being rejected. Give Him the feeling of being overlooked. Give Him the hopelessness. Give Him the weariness and He'll give you strength. Oh, precious Holy Spirit, flood them. Flood them. Flood them. Flood them, I pray, in the name of Jesus.

Now I want you to begin to pray out loud. Begin to talk to Him. Ask Him to do what only He can do. It's the presence of the Holy Spirit here. That's the presence of the Holy Spirit. Dear Jesus, I give you praise. That's the beauty of His presence on you. That's the beauty of His presence on you. Jesus, I give you glory and honor. Touch your people, I pray. Fresh, fresh wind. Healing, Lord. Healing. You need healing in your body. Can you just wave at me, please? Okay, I'll try to come to you here. Everyone else, please pray. The rest of you in the congregation, please stand just out of reverence to what the Lord is doing here. And if you're in your seats, keep a mindful and prayerful attitude. Just pray over these who are down in the front here asking them to do it.

Ma'am, you said you need healing here? What do you need the Lord to do for you? (WOMAN SPEAKING) Stretch your hands toward our sister in the name of Jesus. Healing. That's it. Heal her body. Heal her body, Lord, in Jesus name. That's the power of God going through you. That's the power of God going through you. I give you praise, Jesus.

Who else as I walk by? You needed healing. What do you need God to do for you? Migraine headaches. For how long? In the name of the one whom I serve. Come on, church, pray. In the name of the one whom I serve. Healing power of God flow through her now. That's it. Thank you, Jesus. Lord, bring healing and restoration. Never again, in Jesus name we pray. I want you to say this, church. Stretch your hands toward her, say never again. (AUDIENCE – never again) Never again. In Jesus name.

Now there's a lot who want to pray. I'm going to go briefly by. I won't be able to get the story. I'm just going to lay hands, but remember this, it's not in the touch of man, it's in the touch of Jesus. I'm being obedient to the scripture by laying hands. The rest is on the Lord. So you seek Him as I come by and pray, and I'll lay hands on as many as we can today, and let's believe that the Lord will heal not just up here, but also those of you in your seats and even those of you watching online or wherever you may be watching, if at all. So pray, pray, pray. Hands lifted, and just be lost in this moment of worship focused on Jesus, for the Holy Spirit glorifies Jesus and Jesus alone. In the name. That's it. In the name of the one whom I serve. That's the power of God on you, sister. That's the power of God. Just help her. Help her. That's the power of God. In the name of Jesus. Healing virtue, flow. That's it. Healing virtue, flow. It's the power of God here. Thank you, Jesus. Healing virtue flow. That's it. Like rivers of living water breaking loose over you. Restoration and strength to your body, in the name of Jesus.

Healing virtue. Flow. Flow. Flow. Flow. Flow, flow. In the name of Jesus. The presence of the Lord Jesus. He's healing you. Healing virtue. Lord, I give you praise. You see her cry, Lord? You hear her cry, Lord? Lord, bring restoration to her body, I pray. I command every cell in your body to obey the will of God. Lord, thank you that you're bringing revival to her family. Thank you that every prayer offered before you has been received in Jesus name. I give you the praise, Jesus. I give you the praise, Lord. The glory of God. It's the glory of God. Lord, touch my brother. Touch my brother, Lord. The glory of God. He loves you with an everlasting love. He loves you with an everlasting love. Breaking that power today to break that power of darkness over you, in Jesus name. Never again. Never again, in Jesus name. I give you the glory and the honor. We give you praise, Jesus. Say thank you, Jesus. (AUDIENCE – thank you, Jesus) We thank you, Jesus (AUDIENCE – we thank you, Jesus).

Holy Spirit, we honor you. We honor you. And I pray you'd bless this congregation, Lord. Father, I pray today there would be an impartation that this would be a season, whereas they've been pressing in for the greater, whereas they have been pressing in for the miraculous, I pray, Father, that this would be a season of open heaven; that miracles would abound in this house, in the name of Jesus.

Lord, that when the addicted even step on the property, their chains would be broken. Father, that when the sick would even step on the property, that sickness would begin to lose its hold. Let this be a mighty season of visitation, in the name of Jesus, we pray. And the church said, (AUDIENCE – amen) amen.

I just want to thank you again for the opportunity for allowing me to serve here. I don't take that lightly and I appreciate the time that we spent together. I believe they're going to do another worship song now. Is that what they're doing? Or, I will turn it over to Pastor Bobby here right now. Blessings to you all.
